MANAGEMENT HAS FINALLY BEGUN THE RE-CANVASS FOR THE EXPIRING TEMPORARY TRANSFER TO THE FIBER BUILD IN DORCHESTER. THE PROCESS WILL BE THE SAME AS THE LAST TIME.

THE CXM GARAGES IN LOCAL 2222 WILL BE CANVASSED FOR DORCHESTER. THE NEXT STEP IS TO CANVASS LOCATIONS OUTSIDE OF LOCAL 2222 FOR THE REMAINING SPOTS IN DORCHESTER AND FOR POSITIONS TO BACKFILL THE CXM GARAGES. THE 2222 CANVASS SHOULD BE COMPLETED THIS WEEK AND THE TRANSFER IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN JUNE 4

THE CANVASS FOR TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF SSTs TO WEST ROXBURY HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THE TRANSFER WILL BEGIN ON MONDAY MAY 7th. THIS LOCATION WILL BE PART OF THE NORWOOD ASSOCIATED WORK GROUP.

THE FOUR BIDS FOR THIS LOCATION HAVE CLOSED BUT HAVE NOT BEEN AWARDED YET.

CENTRAL OFFICE MANAGEMENT HAS INFORMED THE UNION THEY WILL BE ENDING ALL TEMPORARY TRANSFERS WITHIN AND BETWEEN ADMINISTRATIVE WORK GROUPS. THE COMPANY WILL BE CANVASSING FOR PERMANENT TRANSFERS, FIRST WITHIN ADMINISTRATIVE WORK GROUPS, THEN TO OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE WORK GROUPS IF NECESSARY.

THE COMPANY ALSO INFORMED THE UNION THAT THEY WILL BE PUTTING A BID OUT FOR A FRAME/TOLL COT AT 6 BOWDOIN SQ.

COEI MANAGEMENT HAS INFORMED THE UNION OF THEIR INTENTION TO UTILIZE AVAILABLE VZB NFO TECHS TO DO SOME EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION WORK. THIS WILL BE SCALED BACK AS THE NEW EI TECHS ARE TRAINED AND QUALIFIED.

THE GRIEVANCE RELATED TO IMPROPER BID NOTIFICATION HAS BEEN HEARD AT LABOR RELATIONS. WE ARE WAITING FOR THE COMPANY'S RESPONSE.

THE UNION AND VERIZON MANAGEMENT MET ON APRIL 24, 2018 TO DISCUSS THE MOVE OF THE CUSTOMER CARE GROUP INTO LOWELL. VERIZON MANAGEMENT STATED THAT THE CLERICAL POSITIONS IN THIS GROUP WILL BECOME SERVICE REP POSITIONS. THE DECISION BY MANAGEMENT WILL CANCEL OUT ANY POTENTIAL SWAPS OF EXISTING CLERKS IN BOWDOIN SQUARE. THE MOVE IS SLATED FOR SEPTEMBER 2018 TIMEFRAME SO I WILL KEEP THE CLERICAL GROUPS IN BOWDOIN SQUARE UPDATED.
